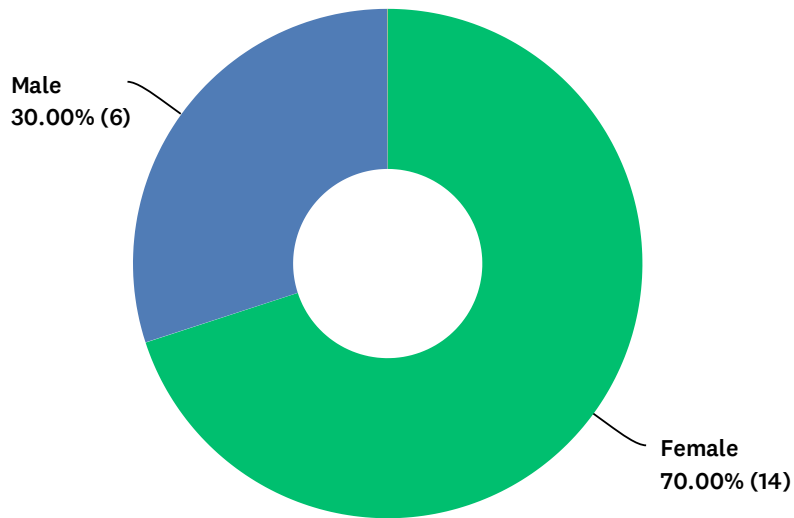

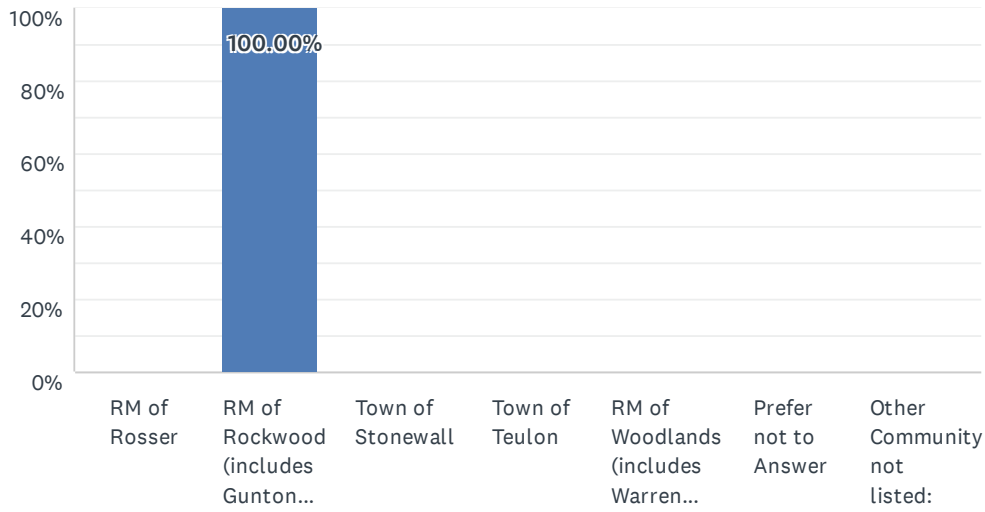

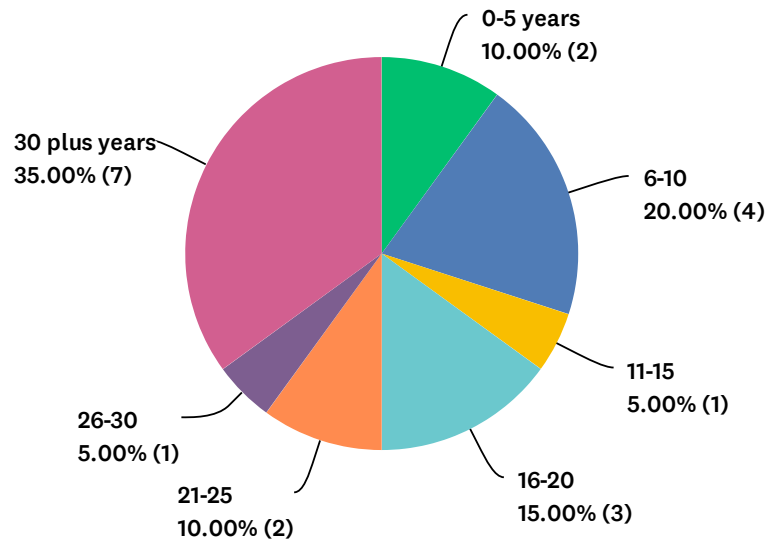

Q4 How long have you lived in your community?

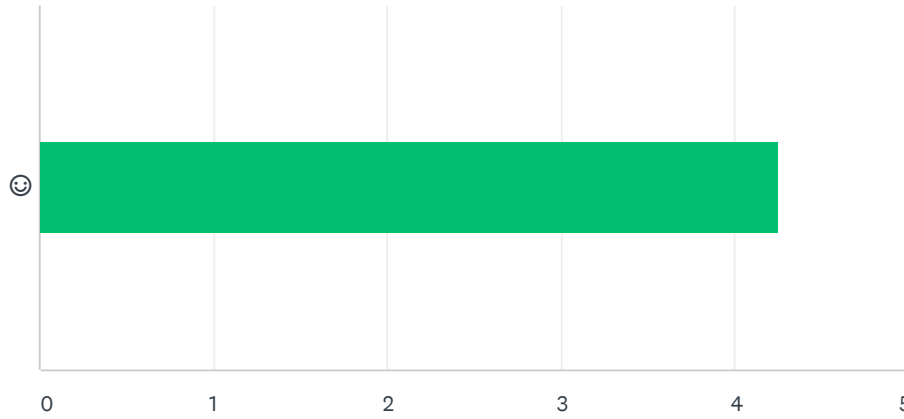
