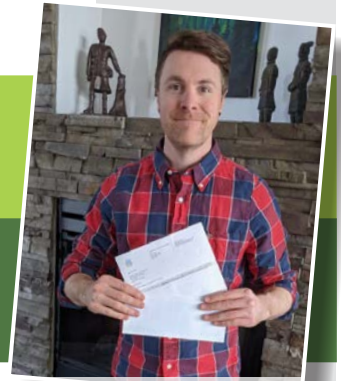

The Interlake Community Foundation (also called “the ICF” or “the Foundation”) provides the citizens of Rockwood, Rosser, Stonewall, Teulon and Woodlands with the opportunity to invest in the future of their community and region forever. The Foundation pools gifts in a capital fund that remains in perpetuity providing citizens with a means of permanently endowing their region and helping to shape its future. The income generated from the capital is distributed as grants to registered charities in the region. To date, we have over \$1,200,000 in assets!

Organizations can apply for grants to fund local projects. Having established broad and flexible criteria, the Foundation can support innovative activities that might not be funded in any other way. Deadline for applications is February 28th of each year.

# Report from Bob Beck | BOARD CHAIR, MAY 25, 2020

2019 was a tremendous year for our organization and I am extremely proud of all we achieved.

In 2019 we were excited to celebrate 25 years. As part of our celebration, we hosted a gala in October attended by current and past board members, donors, grant recipients, and many other valued members of our communities. What a fun evening and tremendous opportunity to share our message.

To commemorate 25 years, our board set an aggressive goal of raising \$250,000 in donations. Considering we were at \$1 Million at the start of the year, we felt this would be a good challenge. I am excited to report that we not only met our challenge, we exceeded it by raising slightly over \$250,000! As part of this, we added 8 new funds in 2019! It's amazing what you can accomplish when you put your efforts together as a team. Thank you to all our donors. Without you, we wouldn't be able to accomplish what we did.

In 2019, we were excited to grant out over \$60,000. In 2020, we have accessed 3 additional grant programs: The Pilot Fund for Gender Equality, the Emergency Community Support Fund and Manitoba Build 150 program which will provide an additional \$85,000 in grant money. Our total grants and awards for this year will reach over \$125,000! As we grow, we are able to help our communities flourish.

This year, we are excited to announce that our board made the decision to become an Affiliate of the Winnipeg Foundation. Their recently expanded Endow Manitoba division provides a lot of support to Manitoba Foundations and we look forward to the many benefits they will bring our organization.

A new collaboration has just been announced and we are proud to be participating. The new \$350 Million Community Emergency Support Fund has been established by the Government of Canada to support vulnerable Canadians. Community Foundations of Canada, The Canadian Red Cross and United Way Canada will deliver the funding. See our website for details on how qualified donees can apply for emergency grants.

Stay tuned for 2020. I have a feeling this year will be another year to remember.

This was live streamed to all three high schools. She had a very impactful and encouraging message and provided a never give up attitude.

Sarasvati continued their work of exploring gender equity through drama. Emily Granger (Sonic Saucers) an artist, filmmaker and musician, had her students making vinyl recordings on plastic plates. Helga Jacobson, an embroidery artist, taught embroidery techniques and mixed media to create personal messages. Conversations flowed in all three sessions which culminated in a wrap up at end of Day 2. Friendships and connections were developed, with the intent to gather for a next steps conversation and a plan to share our combined messages.

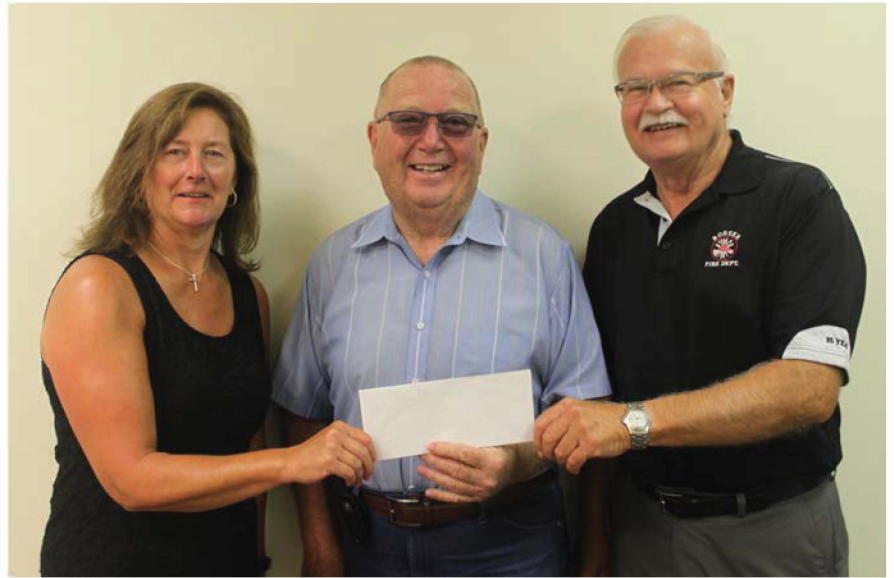
## POSTPONED EVENT

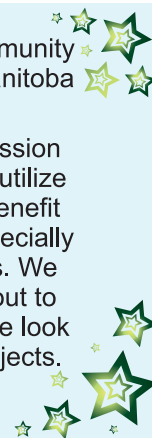

We are very pleased to be able to grant out over \$89,000 in scholarships and community grants in 2020. A large part of this is available because of the \$20,000 from the Manitoba 150 grant program and the \$25,000 from the Pilot Fund for Gender Equality.

For our community granting, we received 26 applications for 2020 and after discussion with members of our grant committee we decided to fund 17 of these. We tried to utilize our funds to the best advantage directing funding into some larger projects that benefit the communities involved. We hope that these projects help their communities especially as the Covid 19 virus is affecting so many activities that we enjoy on a daily basis. We are not presenting these awards in May as we usually do and letters have gone out to successful groups about receiving these grants. Thank you to all applicants and we look forward to 2021 for more exciting opportunities to aid our communities in their projects.
