We currently have over \$11 Million in assets and have grown thanks to gifts made by our supporters. This year alone, we have granted \$2.7 Million to local charities! We bring donors and local charities together through our endowment, spend down and flow through funds. Together, we are "Building for Tomorrow - Today!"

# Report from Bob Beck, ICF's Board Chair

Another year has come and gone, and we have celebrated over 30 years as a Foundation. When I joined the Foundation 25 years ago, we had about \$400,000 in assets. Our goals at that time were to increase community awareness and reach \$1 Million in assets. It took us a few years, but in 2019 we set an aggressive target in conjunction with our 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary, and by year end we were at \$1.2 Million. Today we sit at **over \$10 Million in Funds** and continue to grow.

We are very proud of helping our local charities. We paid out a Spend down grant this year of over \$2.2 Million to Ducks Unlimited Canada for the Harry J. Enns Wetland Discovery Centre at Oak Hammock Marsh, bringing our overall **lifetime total to about \$5.7**Million! These are substantial dollars going back into our communities.

Our board continues to explore new opportunities to grow and help our communities. This year, we finalized a new strategic plan and look forward to the opportunities it will create.

Thank you to everyone for your incredible support over the past 31 years. If you are interested in finding out more about the workings of the Interlake Community Foundation or setting up your own fund, please feel free to talk to any of us. Tracy is a wealth of knowledge and enthusiasm, and our board also enjoys sharing our story. Funds can be set up both personally or for your organization and is a wonderful way to leave a legacy!

Committee Chair, Cheryle McClure
In 2024 we started making our Community
Grants in the fall with great success! This
year we presented our designated grants as
part of our AGM. The June 30<sup>th</sup> deadline for
online Community Grant applications online
portal ran smoothly with only a few
applications coming in paper format. We
hope it was easy for those submitting the
applications. We are still fine tuning the
process and if anyone has feedback we
would love to hear it!

In 2025 we were able to approve Community
Grants to 16 local charities to the total
amount of almost \$60,000. Our 2025
Designated and Flow Through Grants totaled
\$2,648,517. The combined scholarships
awarded were \$20,660. The total amount
that the ICF granted in 2025 reached an
impressive total of \$2,729,177!
Whether a large grant or a small scholarship,
the ICF is proud to serve

our community!


